

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE NEW RECYCLING PROGRAM**

**Q. When will I receive my recycling cart?**

**A. The carts will begin to be delivered the week of May 4<sup>th</sup>. Everyone will have one by May 18<sup>th</sup>.**

**Q. When will the new program begin?**

**A. The week of May 18<sup>th</sup>.**

**Q. Is there a cost for the new 95 gallon wheeled recycling cart?**

**A. No. There is no charge, and no increase in your yearly fee.**

**Q. Why are we switching to single stream recycling?**

**A. It is easier, convenient, and encourages people to recycle more resulting in a cost savings for the Town. It also keeps recycling from blowing away causing litter throughout town and is in a covered cart.**

**Q. Do I need to separate my cans, glass, plastics, newspapers, cardboard, etc?**

**A. No. You need not separate your recyclables or tie up paper and cardboard.**

**Q. Is there be a change to the items we currently recycling?**

**A. No, there is no change to what you recycle. For a list of recycling items go to the Town's Web Site and click on Public Works and then click on Landfill.**

**Q. How will I know when it is a recycling week? Recycling begins the week of May 18<sup>th</sup> and will then be every other week. We suggest you mark a calendar at home with a "R" every other week beginning and including the week of May 18th. If you have a questions if it is a recycling week, just call the Selectman's Office at 668-3838.**

**Q. What do I do with the old blue recycling bin?**

**A. That is for you too keep. If you do not want it, you can bring it to the Landfill on Mountain Road.**

**Q. Will anything change about our normal weekly trash pickup?**

**A. No. Nothing changes. Your weekly trash will still be picked up on your specific day each week.**
